Decarbonisation Project

The first phase of the roofing works has been completed ahead of schedule. This weekend scaffolding will be erected around the hall and the kitchen to allow the second phase to begin next week. This scaffolding will be across the width of the pavement on Flash Lane with a tunnel for pedestrians to walk under. Please take care when arriving and leaving school.

The school field is due to be levelled and re-seeded once the weather conditions are suitable. The temperature of the ground is vital to enable the grass to grow correctly and to make sure that the re-established field is fit for purpose. I have been advised that work will take place between March and May. The company completing the work completed a site visit last week and will contact us as soon as conditions are suitable for work to commence.

It will be summer before the field is established enough to enable us to use it. As I outlined in my letter at the start of the work, in the interim, we have arranged to use the Village Hall field for sporting events and PE lessons as required. We have put various things in place to allow the children as much freedom and space on the playground as possible at this time including: opening up the Trim Trail and the Outdoor Classroom area for breaks and lunchtimes and marking out an area for football which is timetabled for different groups of children.
